pastel: supplies for plein air

[Note: As you put together your supplies and equipment to paint outdoors, think lightweight and portable, find creative ways to simplify everything you carry with you on a painting trip. You will want to have a selection of both soft and hard pastels in various hues, tints and shades.]

Soft Pastels

Many companies sell sets selected for landscape. The larger sets will give you greater choices and require less blending. I recommend that you purchase a high-quality landscape set of no less than 24 colors from one of these companies:

Hard Pastels

I recommend you purchase a small set of 24 or 36—they will last years. These are much less expensive than the soft pastels.

- Stabilo CarbOthello Pastel Pencils | purchase

Pastel Paper/Boards

I prefer to use specifically prepared cards/ papers, which have toothy, gritty coatings on them and a heavy stock. These coatings will accept lots of pastel and reworking without plugging up or going slick. The heavy weight eliminates wrinkling and flapping in the wind. I suggest you purchase prepared papers/boards from any one of these companies:

Boards

You can buy Foamboard cut several inches larger than paper size to tape/mount the paper to.

- Knitting Needle or Straight Skewer | purchase
- View-Finder | purchase (or make your own: Make two "L" shapes out of cardboard, about 7"- 8" on the leg and 1½" wide. Hold together with binder clips)
- Binder Clips and/or Bankers Clasps to hold down the paper in the wind purchase
- A box of wipes to clean your fingers (or latex gloves if you use them)
